POLICY IKA – Grading and Reporting

POLICY JED – Residency, Tuition, and Enrollment

REGULATION JGB-RA – Search and Seizure

Given the passage of HB 130 (searches of students by teachers on field trips), the committee authorized a timeline for regulation changes. POLICY AEB – Long Range Planning

The makeup of the policy by the Policy Committee was reviewed by the Long-Range and Strategy Planning Subcommittee at its meeting. It was the consensus of the Policy Committee that, with minor changes, the policy would be forwarded to Board for tentative action on June 8, 2004.
