| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Newspapers ● Magazines ● Corrugated Cardboard ● Cereal and Other Boxes ● Telephone Books ● Computer and Office Paper ● Newspaper Inserts ● Catalogs ● Unwanted Mail (including window envelopes) ● Paperback Books ● Hardback Books (small quantities can be put in the dumpster, large quantities must be recycled in small batches) ● All other clean and dry paper | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Packing material such as Styrofoam or plastic wrap ● Food soiled paper such as plastic or wax coated liners and pizza boxes ● Wax paper, carbon paper, and laminated materials. ● Beverage containers such as milk or juice cartons ● Paper or cardboard contaminated with paint, chemicals, kitty litter, water or anything else ● Foil gift wrap, paper towels, napkins, and tissues |

Commingled Materials (Bottles and Cans)

| Glass Jars & Bottles | Unbroken green, brown, and clear bottles only. | No other kinds of glass. No lids. |
| Plastic Bottles w/ Necks | Plastics bottles with necks. | No plastics without necks, for example yogurt containers, cream cheese tubs, butter tubs, or plastic cups. |
| Cans | Aluminum, steel, bi-metal cans and clean aluminum foil products. Attached lids are o.k. | No other types of metal can be recycled in the roll-cart toters. Contact SERT for information on recycling Scrap Metal. |
