



“Tap and Stack”

Increasing Recycling Rates...one lunch at a time.



Great News! All elementary schools will start the new year with recyclable plastic lunch containers. These containers can be placed in any commingled recycling receptacle.

Encourage students to tap their leftover food into a trash can. Lunch containers can then be stacked on top of the recycle bins (pictured below) in the cafeteria.

Make recycling fun by encouraging your students to tap and stack.

- Step 1: Tap your food into the trash.
- Step 2: Stack your tray for easy recycling*.



From cafeteria to commingled. Put in toter or 2 yard with bottles and cans

*If there is food remaining in tray please do not stack. Please place containers with food in the trash. We do not want food to get into our recycling stream.
