



Social Studies Grading Procedure

Students' grades will be based on how well they have learned the skills and knowledge for each unit. Students will have many chances to practice new skills and develop their knowledge. They will receive feedback, so they can use it to improve and meet the learning goals. A student's final grade will be based on 10% Homework, 10% BCR, 20% Quizzes (Formative Assessments), 20% End of Unit Test (Summative), 40% Classroom Assignments and Projects.

*Late work and missing work: Each assignment will have a due date. This is the date by which students are expected to submit the assignment on time. Their grade will drop one letter grade if it is not turned in by this due date. A deadline date is the last day that an assignment will be accepted for the grade. This will be one week after the grade is posted on Edline. Work will not be accepted after this one week, unless you have spoken to me about why the work is late and I have given you extra time. Work not turned in by the deadline will receive a zero. One Assessment may be redone per quarter. The original work must accompany the revised work in order for it to be graded. **TESTS CANNOT BE RETAKEN.***
