2009-2010 SUGGESTED SCHOOL SUPPLIES

ALL GRADES

- Binder — 3-Ring (3 inch)
- Bulldog Time Book (may be a book borrowed from the Baker Library Media Center)
- Calculator* — students are encouraged to purchase their own calculator(s) for their academic career. If you choose to purchase a calculator, you should be aware of the models being used in specific classes:
Math 6, Math 7, Investigations in Math, Algebra Prep – TI-30 Scientific Calculator with fraction capability (should have an —A b/c|| or —unit|| button)
Algebra 1 and Honors Geometry – TI 83* plus *or* TI 84* graphing calculator
** Parents ... if you purchase a Texas Instruments (TI) calculator, please turn in the Proof of Purchase to the Baker Math Resource Teacher. This will enable Baker to receive free supplies.*
- Dividers for 3-Ring Binder (one set/min. 5 subjects)
- Erasers (e.g., tops of #2 pencils)
- Glue Stick
- Notebook Paper (loose leaf/wide ruled)
- Pencil Pouch (sturdy, for 3-ring binder)
- Pencils (#2)
- Pens, Ball Point (black *or* blue)
- Textbook Covers (you do not need to purchase book covers – brown paper bags turned inside-out will be fine)

STUDENT FEES 2009-2010

Student fees are collected by individual class teachers within a department.

Art - Grades 6, 7, and 8: Materials for take home projects: \$3.00

Math - Grades 6, 7, and 8: Students who choose to use a school-owned TI-83 calculator instead of buying their own will need to put down a deposit of \$50. The deposit will be returned to the student's parents/guardians when the calculator is returned in good condition. However, students who lose or damage a school-owned calculator will be assigned a financial obligation for the cost of the calculator (less any deposit paid).

Health/Physical Education - Grades 6, 7, and 8: No Fees

For PE class, students may wear a Baker uniform or a plain t-shirt and plain gym shorts (inseam 4-8 inches); they will need to wear a supportive, sturdy pair of sneakers and a pair of socks; they are encouraged to bring deodorant and sunscreen; for cold weather days, they are encouraged to bring any color sweatshirt, sweatpants, hat and gloves. All students will be issued a personal gym locker with a built in combination lock.

Optional uniform purchase — if students would like to purchase the Baker PE uniform, the costs are as follows: t-shirt \$10 (imprinted with our school's bulldog logo); shorts \$15 (imprinted with our school's bulldog logo); Baker sweatpants \$15, and hooded sweatshirts \$25. Students will be given the opportunity to purchase these items the first week of school. Checks should be made payable to Baker Middle School.
