MARCH – MAY: ASSESSMENT AND PLACEMENT

Contact the Assessment Center at the campus you plan to attend to make an appointment. Testing may be by appointment only. You must bring one form of photo identification (D) to the assessment site.

- If American English is your first language and you were educated in the US from elementary school through high school: Make an appointment to take the ACCUPLACER.
- IF English is not your first language: Make an appointment to take the AMERICAN ENGLISH TEST (LOEP) Test (BY APPOINTMENT ONLY).

You are EXEMPT from the ACCUPLACER if you have SAT scores of 550 each for Critical Reading, Math & Writing; ACT 24 composite.
You are EXEMPT from the ESL ACCUPLACER with a TOEFL score of at least 90 Internet version; 575 (paper format) or 231 (computer format).

CONSIDERING THE MILITARY????

US SERVICE ACADEMY APPOINTMENTS / NOMINATIONS

The process to apply to the Military Academy should have started **NO LATER THAN** the beginning of your junior year.

- In the spring take the SAT (Reasoning).
- File a pre-candidate questionnaire with the Academy of interest to you.
- Obtain Congressional Representative and U. S. Senators applications packets. Complete and return the ‘Application for Nomination’ packet by **early fall of your senior year**.

To maximize your chances of receiving a nomination, apply in writing to your U.S. Senators and Representative. Each will submit a number of competitive nominations for each available vacancy. **U.S. Senators and Representatives only nominate candidates for admission consideration.** The final selection decisions are made by each academy.
