1. What is required to fully implement the Middle School Policy?

- 2. What would be the cost of a modified interscholastic program that would offer one boys' and one girls' activity per season and would include a reduced number of games/activities? What was the least expensive interscholastic program model previously provided?
- 3. What are the duties and responsibilities of the middle school director position?
- 4. What has been the annual inflationary increases for textbooks over the past three years?
- 5. What is the cost of implementing distance learning at the 12th Grade? What courses would be appropriate for this approach?
- 6. Provide a four-year history of funding for evening high school.

- 7. What is the cost of adding all-day kindergarten to ten more schools?
- 8. What would it take to serve all eligible Head Start students? What is the cost of one class?
- 9. How much could be saved by charging a fee for the Richard Montgomery IB exam? How could the savings be redirected?
- 10. What is the per pupil rate from the state for the Limited English Proficiency grant?
- 11. Are there other communities experiencing a need for ESOL parent outreach resources beyond the three clusters currently being addressed?
- 12. What efforts are being undertaken to reduce special education legal costs?
- 13. What resources are in the budget to eliminate the current deficit in special education?
