Individual Student Organizational Tools/ Personal Supplies and Course Fees 2009-2010

Students are encouraged to bring the following individual organizational tools and personal supplies to school.

Kindergarten – Grade 2 Organizational tools/personal supplies

- 6 boxes pencils, presharpener, 12 per box
- 12 glue sticks
- 2 crayons –48 per box
- 2 erasers – pink pearl
- 1 plastic pencil box

Grades 3 – 5 Organizational tools/personal supplies

- 6 boxes pencils, presharpener, 12 per box
- 2 pens of each color – Round stick – medium ballpoint (black, blue, and red)
- 2 erasers – pink pearl
- 1 3 ring binder – 2” spine
- 2 loose leaf paper (200 sheets)
- 1 zipper pencil pouch with grommets – 3 hole punched to fit in binder
- 3 plastic pocket folders – 2 pocket, 3 hole punched (one of each color: red, green, and blue)
- 2 crayons –48 per box
- 4 glue sticks

Kindergarten – grade 5 Course fees

During the first week of school, we *recommend* students purchase from College Gardens the following items:

- Kindergarten: \$1.00 (communication folder)
- Grade 1: \$1.00 (communication folder)
- Grade 2: \$3.50 (communication folder and agenda book)
- Grade 3: \$5.50 (communication folder, agenda book, and a recorder*)
- Grade 4: \$3.50 (communication folder and agenda book)
- Grade 5: \$3.50 (communication folder and agenda book)
