

≥3 at the Standard Level (1-2 years of study)

#### IBCP Core Components

- > Personal and Professional Skills (PPS)
- ➤ Language Development (50 hours)
- > Service Learning (50 hours)
- Reflective Project (50 hours)

The core components are integrated into the PPS course

#### **IBCP** Courses

- Each student must study at least 2 DP subjects.
- One course must be studied over 2 years
- Subjects can be studied at either Higher Level or Standard Level

IB Retention and Graduation Rates






## DP Enrollment and Graduation Data

## University enrollment and graduation

DP students in the US have higher rates of university enrollment and graduation at four-year institutions compared to the national average.


- DP cohort
- National cohort














Persistence: Did CP graduates return for their second year of higher education?

Of the three main outcomes studied, one-year persistence showed the largest advantage for the CP over the national average.

Immediate enrollment with persistence,

- 93% of CP graduates at four-year institutions persisted for one year, as compared to 82%<sup>5</sup> nationally in 2014.
- Overall, once CP graduates enrolled, almost all (89%) return for their sophomore year, which is 17 percentage points higher than the national average (72% in 2014).
- Gender, race/ethnicity and low-income status were not significant factors in predicting students' likelihood of persisting.





### IB and College Credit

#### College Credit

- Colleges ultimately determine how much credit they will give
- >HL exams usually receive credit at colleges
- Many colleges give credit for SL courses but not all
- Credit is usually determined by scores on exams and course

## Advanced Standing (IB Diploma Students)

#### Salisbury University

Students who earn an IB Diploma will be awarded up to 30 credits, for scores of 4 or above on both the higher level and the standard level IB exams.

#### Virginia Tech

Up to 38 semester credit hours may be granted for those earning the IB diploma

#### Advanced Standing

#### **Towson University**

Students who earn an IB diploma will be awarded 30 units toward the bachelor's degree and receive sophomore standing.

#### Franklin and Marshall

International Baccalaureate (IB) diploma recipients with a total score of 30 or more are awarded eight course credits (one full year) toward the Franklin & Marshall degree.

## What Should I Take in 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Grade?

- A rigorous challenging academic program of study
- Consider taking AP U S. History and AP NSL
- Complete your P.E., Art, Technology Education and Health credit
- Consider taking one of the pathways
