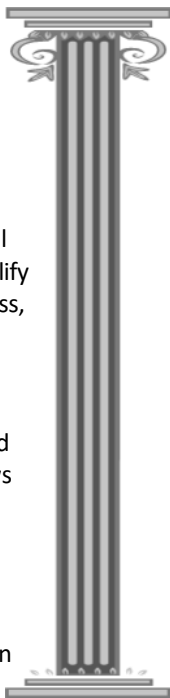

Before a test, a student needs a full night’s sleep, a good breakfast, comfortable school clothing, a little understanding if they’re anxious or upset, and a reminder to charge their Chromebooks.

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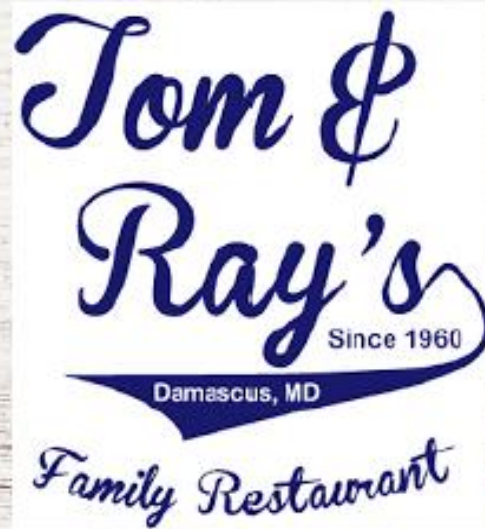

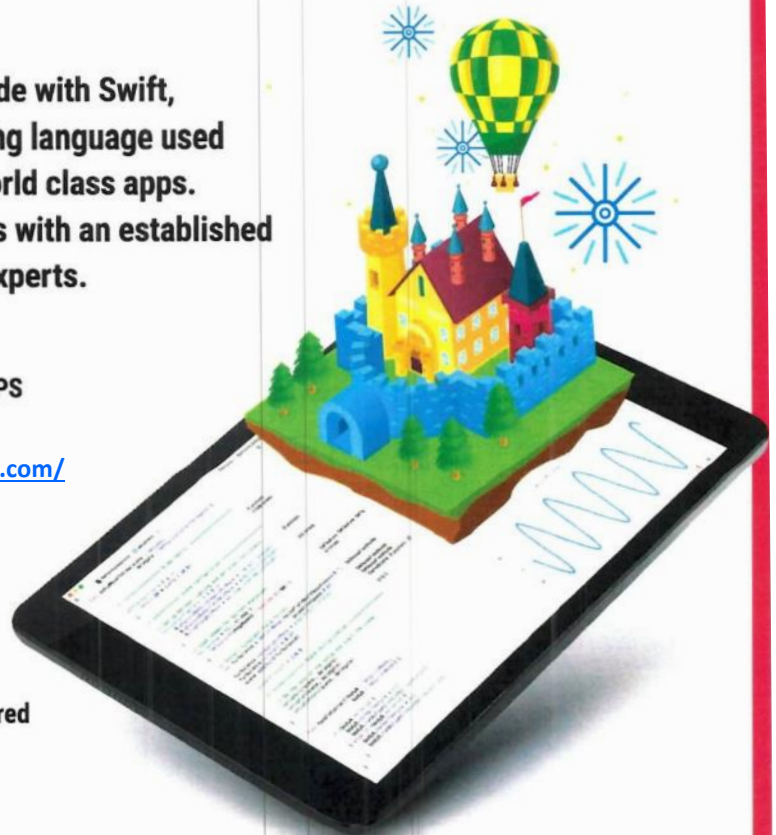
