### A Message from the Health Room — Vision and Hearing Screenings

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Vision and Hearing screenings were held at your child's school on June 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>.

All children enrolled in Grade 8 were screened for hearing and vision if they were in school on the screening days.

If you did not receive this referral form in the US Mail and your child was present on the screening day, then your child passed.

If your child did not pass the screening, a referral letter has been mailed to you via U.S. mail. The letter has screening results and information on follow-up.
