

Mr. Levine's Message

Greetings Bulldog Families,

I hope this message finds you well.

Marking period one interim reports were submitted by staff on Friday, September 27. Parents, guardians, and students will be able to view interim grades/reports through ParentVUE and StudentVUE. Interim reports will be mailed home for parents/guardians without an active ParentVUE account.

Here are a few reminders about Attendance:

Absence — Attendance in school is required by law. If a student will be absent from school or will be arriving late, a parent/guardian is expected to call Attendance at 240-207-2441 each day of the absence to report the absence/tardiness. A phone call must be followed up by a note.

A student returning to school after an absence must turn in a note to the Attendance Secretary signed by the parent/ guardian. An absence cannot be excused without a note signed by the parent/guardian. There will be a limit of three school days following the absence to submit the written note. All undocumented absences are classified as unexcused. The note must contain the following: student's name (first and last), student ID, grade, date(s) of absence, reason for absence, parent/guardian signature, and parent/guardian contact number. Providing a note does not guarantee that the absence will be excused. According to Maryland State Law, only the following absences are considered lawful/excused (tardiness is considered to be a short absence):

- Court Summons
- · Death in Family
- Illness of Student *
- · Previously Approved Activity
- Lack of Authorized Transportation. This does not include students denied MCPS authorized transportation for disciplinary reasons. It also does not include missing the bus.
- Religious Holiday
- Hazardous Weather Conditions
- State of Emergency
- Suspension

Absence for any other reason must be approved by the principal prior to the absence. A letter should be addressed to the principal giving the dates and the reason(s) for the proposed absence. This letter must be received a minimum of three days prior to the first day of absence. The principal is not obligated to approve an absence even if a note is provided.

* In accordance with regulation JEA-RA II.A.3.d.3, "The principal may require a physician's certificate from the parent or guardians of the student ..." and a physician's note will be required after a five-day absence.

Early Dismissal — A student who needs to leave before regular dismissal time must bring a note, signed by the parent/guardian, explaining the absence, to the Attendance window by 8:30 a.m. (or as early in the day as possible). The student will receive a pass from the Attendance Office which is to be presented to the teacher at the beginning of the class from which the student is to be dismissed. It is the student's responsibility to keep an eye on the time so they can be dismissed at the requested "to leave

at" time without being called. Providing a note or signing out your child does not guarantee that the early release will be excused.

Late Arrival — Students arriving at school at a time which prevents them from being in their Period 1 class on time should come to the main front door for entry into the building. A student arriving late must sign in at the Attendance window and turn in a note, signed by the parent/guardian, explaining the absence, or the parent/guardian must sign in the student. A student arriving without a note or parent/guardian signature will be marked unexcused. Providing a note or signing in your child does not guarantee that the tardiness will be excused.

Outreach and Admission Process Information Overview for Regional/Countywide High School Application Programs

Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) offers a wide range of high school application programs for students entering Grades 9–12. These programs have a centralized admissions process, which begins with a common online application. The admission process opens in early October 2024.

- For students entering Grades 9–12 in 2025–2026, the regional/countywide high school application programs admission and timelines are available at: www.montgomeryschoolsmd.org/curriculum/specialprograms/high/.
- MCPS has streamlined the Grade 8 high school application process by providing one common online application for all programs via Synergy. Grades 9–11 will apply electronically through a link on the website.
- Program eligibility for current Grade 8 students is based on the student's address and middle school. <u>List of Programs by</u> <u>Home/Base High School for Grade 8 Students</u>.
- For Grades 9–11 students, it is based on the home address only. <u>List of Programs for Grade 9-11 Students</u>.
- All MCPS parents/guardians of students in Grades 8–11 will receive communication regarding the high school programs during the weeks of September 9 and 16, 2024, respectively.
- The criteria-based application programs will continue with multiple academic measures and a committee review. The admission process will continue with student criteria such as the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP), report card grades, and student application.
- The High School Common Application for Grade 8 students will be online in ParentVUE.
- Students in private schools must have an active MCPS ID to access the high school common application on ParentVUE.

- October 4, 2024

 Application for Regional/Countywide High School Application Programs (ParentVUE and Google) opens.
- November 1, 2024-Application Deadline for all programs.

Protect Yourself Online: Essential Cybersecurity Measures

RECOGNIZE PHISHING

Phishing scams can deceive you into revealing sensitive information or downloading harmful attachments, putting your device and data at risk.

Common signs of a phishing attempt:

- Misspelled email address or unknown/external sender
- Urgent/alarming language that calls for "immediate action"
- Unexpected attachments or suspicious links
- · Requests for personal or financial information



UTILIZE PASSWORD PROTECTION

The average person has around 100 passwords to remember. Passwords are the key to accessing personal information.



How to secure your information:

- Use a password manager
- Always log off all devices
- Use hard to guess passwords
- Avoid reusing the same password

BEWARE OF SOFTWARE & MALWARE

Malware is an umbrella term for software designed to harm or exploit a device or network.

How to prevent and protect:

- · Update all software, apps, and devices to keep them current
- Back up your data frequently
- · Carefully check all emails and messages for suspicious links



USE MULTI-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION (MFA)

MFA provides an extra layer of security in addition to a password when logging into accounts and apps, like a face scan or a code sent by text.

- · Reduces fraud and identify theft
- Reduces possibility of phishing attempts

INCLEMENT WEATHER and EMERGENCY SCHOOL SYSTEM CLOSURES

The safety of our Montgomery County Public School (MCPS) community is critical and being able to communicate with students, staff, and families during severe weather or other emergencies is of the utmost importance. Sometimes a change in operational status for the school system is necessary due to severe weather or other emergencies. The operating status options for the 2024-2025 school year include:

- Code Green Normal Operations
- Code Yellow Delayed Opening
- Code Blue Early Dismissal
- Code Orange Schools Closed/Offices Telework
- Code Red School System Closed

MCPS is prepared to address weather-related concerns including snow, ice, flooding, hurricanes, tornadoes, excessive heat, and other emergencies that may require a change in operational status for schools and offices. The MCPS Inclement Weather Team tracks weather patterns and traffic conditions, as well as benchmarks with surrounding districts and county agencies to make recommendations to the Superintendent related to the district's operating status. Once a decision has been made by the superintendent based on research, analysis, and recommendations from the team, that decision is communicated to staff, students, and families.

The safety of our MCPS community is critical, and being able to communicate with students, staff, and families during severe weather or other emergencies is of the utmost importance.
