MEMORANDUM

Subject: Mitigation of Learning Disruption (03-08-2022-02-A, -B, -C, -D)

During the *Mitigation of Learning Disruption* discussion, Board members requested the following information:

Question A

Dr. Docca requested clarification regarding the drop percentage for Non-FARMS Black or African American students in the fall 2021 *MAP-M* scores as noted on slides 7 and 8 versus the overall percentage of the same student demographic availing themselves of tutoring resources as noted on slide 28. On slide 28, 28.8 percent of Black/African American students are noted as using tutoring resources yet the drop percentages noted on slides 7 and 8 is 28.1 percent: What accounts for the disparity in the numbers?

Response A

The slides referenced were unrelated and in two sections of the presentation. Slides 7 and 8 reported fall 2021, actual performance of students at or greater than 50 percentile on Measures of Academic Progress–Mathematics (MAP-M), among specific student focus groups in middle and high school. Slide 28 reflects demographic breakdown of students participating in Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) tutoring across all grade levels.

Question B

Ms. Silvestre requested additional information regarding the students that attended summer school in 2021: On slide 39, are we sure that the participants that attended summer school representative of the overall school system?

Response B

Slide 39 is an example of an analysis completed for Grade 3 in local summer programs. This does not include students in the Extended Learning Opportunities (Title I schools) or Extended School Year programs, therefore it does not represent districtwide analysis.

Question C

Ms. Silvestre requested additional information regarding the number of students who are attending the offered tutoring sessions, including demographic information and school location.

Response C

Through a combination of MCPS tutors and tutoring provided by external partners, student participation continues to grow, as additional MCPS staff are available and services from partners expand.

As of April 1, 2022, participation with MCPS tutors is as follows:

In addition to the tutoring provided by MCPS staff members, students also have access to FEV Tutor and Tutor Me Education. These two vendors provide two different types of tutoring support for our students. The first is an on-demand, homework help model where any student is able to access a tutor to receive support on an assignment. The second model is a high dosage of ongoing, scheduled support with a consistent tutor to support the major content areas using

MCPS curricula. The attached chart captures the number of students receiving support from these vendors at each school as of April 1, 2022. This number is increasing daily as more students are being scheduled to receive tutoring.

Question D

Mrs. Evans requested information regarding the student participation numbers for the tutoring services once transportation is provided.

Question Response D

As of March 26, 2022, eleven schools requested additional after-school transportation service to support tutoring, which is being scheduled for activity bus routing. We expect an increase in student participation as a direct result of transportation being provided. Participation information will be provided in a future update.
