Subject: ACTION: Grade 2 Concerts at The Music Center at Strathmore

Summary

- Grade 2 students will be attending the National Philharmonic Concerts at The Music Center at Strathmore, 5301 Tuckerman Lane, North Bethesda, Maryland, November 19–22, 2013.
- There are no costs for elementary schools in association with this program.
- Attachment A, *Instructions for General Music Teachers and Grade 2 Classroom Teachers*, provides general information regarding the National Philharmonic Concerts at The Music Center at Strathmore.
- The concert schedule with the date, time, and transportation information for your school's Grade 2 participation can be found in Attachment B.
- This program is aligned with the Maryland State Curriculum for Elementary Music and the National Standards for Music Education.
- Students attending the morning concerts will need to eat lunch when they return to school.
- Students attending afternoon concerts will need to eat lunch prior to their departure from school.
- Instructional materials for the general music teachers are located on the National Philharmonic Orchestra's website at www.nationalphilharmonic.org/studentconcerts.
- Leave requests for a half-day substitute for your general music teacher need to be submitted on Montgomery County Public Schools Form 430-94: *Professional Leave (PRO)*. The form must include the name and five-digit identification number of the music substitute, the job number, principal's signature, and the account code K12 12101 000 03 501081.

- Please have your school administrative secretary submit a bus field trip ticket to Ms. Georgia L. Cornell, senior field trip coordinator, Transportation Support Services Unit, Department of Transportation, by **October 25, 2013**.
- Please share this information with your Grade 2 teachers and your general music teacher, requesting they send the school permission form home for Grade 2 students to participate in this field trip (Attachment C).
- General music teachers should send a copy of their leave forms to Ms. Katherine A. Murphy, content specialist, Fine Arts, Carver Educational Services Center, Room 256, no later than **November 22, 2013**.

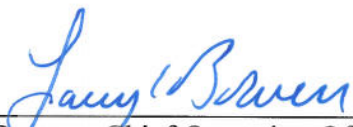
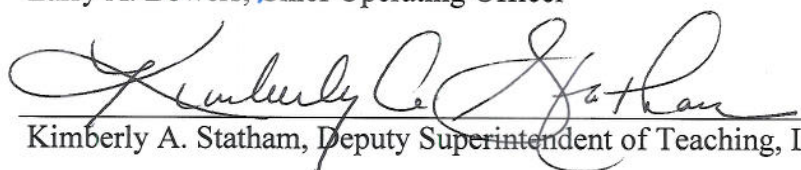

Instructions for General Music Teachers and Grade 2 Classroom Teachers
for the National Philharmonic Concerts
at The Music Center at Strathmore

Directions: Please read this document thoroughly, and provide a copy for each Grade 2 teacher and each general/choral music teacher.

General Information

- Students may not sit in the front rows of the balconies, but ushers may seat teachers there in order to create enough seating space.
- Please do not have students bring pencils and paper for notes. This is a safety issue when going up and down the steps.
- Parents may not drop off or pick up students at the concert.
- Please contact Ms. Katherine A. Murphy via e-mail if there are any special needs (wheelchairs, hard of hearing, etc.) so Strathmore staff members can make arrangements and be prepared.

Prior to the Event

- Inform students and teachers that no photography (video or still) or audio recordings will be permitted during this event.
- Students attending the 10:35 a.m. concert should eat lunch when they return to their school at 1:30 p.m. A light snack before boarding the buses at 9:30 a.m. is suggested.
- Students attending the 12:15 p.m. concert should eat lunch at 10:35 a.m. at school prior to boarding buses at 11:10 a.m. A light snack after returning to school at 1:50 p.m. is suggested.
- Students and teachers will not be permitted to eat on the buses or at The Music Center at Strathmore.
- Please make sure that students refrain from chewing gum or eating candy at the concert.
- Review the preconcert materials and Concert Manners page on the National Philharmonic website at www.nationalphilharmonic.org/studentconcerts.

When Arriving at The Music Center at Strathmore

- Your bus will be given a number when it pulls up to the curb at The Music Center; an adult guide from Strathmore will greet you.
- **For identification purposes, your bus number will be referenced**, rather than the name of your school.
- Designate a lead teacher to lead the line of students and another teacher to supervise students at the end of the line. Each teacher needs to know the total number of people on their bus and will carry a "bus number card."
- Groups from "Even" number assigned buses will walk behind The Music Center and climb 32 outdoor steps to enter the first floor "Concert Seats."
- Groups from "Odd" number assigned buses will walk into The Music Center and climb 72 indoor steps to the Promenade, Grand, and Upper tier seats. In these upper tiers, no students will be permitted to sit in the front row seats. We are asking that **teachers** coming from

“Odd” number buses fill in these first row seats on their assigned level to allow for maximum seating.

Professional Leave for General Music Teachers Only

- Leave requests for a half-day substitute for your general music teacher need to be submitted on MCPS Form 430-94: *Professional Leave (PRO)*. The form must include the name and five-digit identification number for the music substitute, the job number, and the principal's signature.
- Include the account code K12 12101 000 03 501081 on the leave form.
- Please contact your half-day music substitute teacher, and send a copy of your leave slip via Pony to Ms. Katherine A. Murphy, content specialist, Fine Arts, Carver Educational Services Center, Room 256.

School Identification Required

- We have stressed that only students, teachers, and one general music teacher be permitted to attend. This is to allow for enough seats for all of our students. At no time will parents or other adults be permitted to enter The Music Center. In order for us to enforce this policy, we ask that you display your school ID badge when entering The Music Center.

Restroom Considerations

- There will be ample time for most students attending the 10:35 a.m. concert to be escorted by their teacher to the restrooms before 10:35 a.m.
- If students need to visit the restroom after that time, we encourage you to take students to the restroom during the last 10 minutes of the concert rather than wait for the concert to end. This will help us to empty the concert hall and keep the buses on schedule.

Student Head Counts

- Please do your head count prior to exiting The Music Center. Keep a close eye on your line of students along the way to the bus. Do not redo your head count while boarding or while on the bus. Once the last student boards, the bus must pull out in order to keep the process moving.

Medical Attention

- We have prepared the site with the focus on student safety. In the event a child needs medical attention, a Registered Pediatric Nurse will be centrally located at The Music Center.
