
FUND OUR IT IS TIME TO REINVEST IN OUR STUDENTS. FUTURE Growing Needs/Fewer Resources

Together, we must achieve full funding of the budget to ensure every child has the opportunity for success. The FY 2017 Operating Budget includes resources to serve more than **2,500** additional students; **reduce class sizes**; **close the achievement gap**; improve students' literacy and math skills; and build the cultural proficiency of staff.
