IN PERSON HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM

- » Students attend from 8:00 am to 12:30 pm daily
- » Each .5 credit course lasts three weeks

CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM

- » Virtual Only
- » Blended learning opportunity with 10 hours of required synchronous (Virtual) instruction, and approximately 30-40 hours of asynchronous (independent) work per course
- » Each .5 credit course lasts three weeks
