

## How to safely remove chemical-resistant gloves after use

















## Steps:

- 1. Grasp the outside of one glove, at the wrist, with your other gloved hand (do not touch your skin).
- 2. Peel the glove off, down and away from your face and body, while turning it inside-out. Peeling the glove off away from you prevents chemicals that are on the gloves from splashing onto you.
- 3. As you remove the inside-out glove, ball it up inside your gloved hand.
- 4. Slide a bare finger or two under the wrist of your gloved hand (do not touch the outside of the glove).
- 5. Use your finger(s) to peel the glove off, turning it inside-out, while your gloved hand continues to hold the balled up first glove.
- 6. The second glove should now be removed, turned inside-out, and wrapped around the first glove.
- 7. Place the gloves in the trash.
- 8. Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water. Do not use hand sanitizer as a substitute for washing this will not effectively remove chemicals from your hands and can increase chemical absorption.
