Funding

Up to \$1,500: Individual Projects – Individual departments, schools, & staff

Up to \$5,000: Collaborative Projects – Multiple departments &/or schools

Key Eligibility Requirements

- Applicant is MCPS employee
- Project & funds benefit MCPS community
- Project or related work not in regular MCPS budget
- Ability to use funds by June 30, 2024
- Project has single project lead
- Alignment with priorities in MCPS Strategic Plan, Blueprint for Maryland's Future, +/or MCPS Antiracist System Audit
- Funds will not be used for indirect costs, grant administration fees, lobbying, religious purposes, childcare*, salaries or consultant fees*, transportation costs*, or recording or computer equipment*

Key Application Components

MCPSEF seeks to ensure application submission is easy, and encourages you to submit brief responses and/or information from grant proposals you have used previously for an MCPSEF or other funding opportunity.

- Strengthening MCPS community, caregiver, family, and guardian connections
- Developing strength, sustainability, scale, scope, evaluation, planning, &/or collaborative opportunities for new and existing projects
- Providing materials to advance student learning
- Facilitating collaborative staff professional development, including mentoring, shared learning, & trainings
- Supporting cross-trainings and collaborative efforts, such as transportation, paraprofessionals, or other support professional involvement in planning, educational initiatives, & community-facing events
