Personal Mobile Devices (PMD) at School - A personal mobile device (PMD) refers to any non-MCPS-issued device used to send or receive data via voice, video, or text. Mobile phones, e-readers, tablets, personal computers, smart watches, or other devices equipped with microphones, headphones, speakers, and/or cameras are all considered PMDs.

Elementary school students <u>are not permitted</u> to have cell phones or other portable mobile devices at school during the school day <u>unless</u> a <u>written request from a parent is approved</u> by the principal. If approved, students are allowed to turn on/use PMDs only before and after the student day. Student Day starts at the time that students arrive and ends at the time of dismissal. Elementary school students are not permitted to use PMDs during instructional periods, lunch periods, recess, or between classes/during transitional time.

Students who do not adhere to these guidelines are subject to consequences per the <u>student</u> <u>code of conduct.</u>

The Office of Accelerated and Enriched Instruction recently sent information in ParentVue and US Mail to parents of students in grade 2 and to parents of students in grades 3 and 5 who are new to MCPS or have not previously met the criteria for gifted and talented designation. The messages contain information about the GT process and directions to access and complete a parent input form.

To learn more about this process please visit https://bit.ly/MCPS-GT-24-25. Your input is an essential data source for the GT identification process. Forms **must** be completed and submitted on or before February 28, 2025.

If your child has been identified as "gifted and talented" by another school system, MCPS will honor that designation. To do so, the parent/guardian **must** complete the <u>2024-2025 Prior Gifted and Talented Designation Form</u> and submit the identification/eligibility letter and official testing report to their school's elementary Gifted and Talented (GT) Liaisons, Mrs. Gobourne and Mrs. Siegel for the Office of Accelerated and Enriched Instruction (AEI) to review.
