★ MARYLAND COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENT PROGRAM (MCAP) ★ - Students in grade 5 will take the MCAP assessment for Math on April 8th and 9th. Practice tests are available here for students to familiarize themselves with the items and formats used for the different MCAP assessments. - Be on time on the day of testing Students who arrive at school late will not be allowed into the classroom during a testing session and will be required to test on a make-up day.
