Literacy SMARTIE Goals

School Literacy Goal (This represents the overall **student achievement** of an underserved focus group(s). Achieving this goal will be essential in order to accomplish the District goal for <u>all</u> students and address the root cause of inequity at the school level):

Improvement in School Literacy Achievement: By the end of 2024-2025, at least 82% of African American and 54% of Hispanic students in grades K-2 will meet the academic milestone for literacy on their DIBELS Composite score for the spring administration (from 82%-88% and 50%-56%, respectively).

By the end of 2024-2025, at least 47% of African American and 39% of Hispanic students in grades 3-5 will meet the academic milestone for literacy on their MAP-R spring administration.f

Math SMARTIE Goals

School Math Goal (This represents the overall **student achievement** of an underserved focus group(s). Achieving this goal will be essential in order to accomplish the District goal for <u>all</u> students and address the root cause of inequity at the school level):

Improvement in School Math Achievement:

By the end of 2024-2025, at least 34% of African American and Hispanic students will meet proficiency on MCAP with a score of 3 or 4 (from 29%-34%).

Projected Individual Student Growth:

By the end of 2024-2025, at least 30% of Hispanic students will exceed their individual projected growth goals on the Measurement of Academic Progress in Math (MAP-P/M) assessment. (from 20%-30% from Fall to Winter administration).

Culture/Climate SMARTIE Goals

By June 2025, 85% of students will respond positively to questions related to trusting relationships as measured by the Measurable Results Assessment (MRA) in Leader in Me.

Well-Being SMARTIE Goals

By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, school leaders will work with the school community to decrease the number of Hispanic students who are chronically absent by 5%. (from 29%-24%).
