Literacy SMARTIE Goals

School Literacy Goal (This represents the overall **student achievement** of an underserved focus group(s). Achieving this goal will be essential in order to accomplish the District goal for all students, and address the root cause of inequity at the school level):

- **K-1:** By June 2025, at least 70% of Hispanic students will meet the literacy benchmark on DIBELS with composite scores for Spring administration.
- **2 - 3 :** By June 2025, at least 65% of Hispanic students will meet the literacy benchmark on DIBELS or MAP - R with composite scores for Spring administration.
- **4 - 5 :** By June 2025, at least 80 % of Hispanic students will exceed the projected RIT score on MAP-R based on their initial achievement level.
 - Students at Achievement Level 1 will grow by 125% or more of the NWEA Fall to Spring Projected Growth
 - Students at Achievement Level 2 will grow by 120% or more of the NWEA Fall to Spring Projected Growth
 - Students at Achievement Level 3 will grow by 115% or more of the NWEA Fall to Spring Projected Growth.
 - Students at Achievement Level 4 will grow by 110% or more of the NWEA Fall to Spring Projected Growth.
- By June 2025, at least 31% of grade 3 - 5 students who receive Special Education services will meet the academic milestone for literacy on MCAP for the spring administration (from 29.1%) (ATSI)

Math SMARTIE Goals

School Math Goal (This represents the overall **student achievement** of an underserved focus group(s). Achieving this goal will be essential in order to accomplish the District goal for all students, and address the root cause of inequity at the school level):

- **K-1:** By June 2025, at least 65% of Hispanic students will meet proficiency on Measurement of Academic Progress in math (MAP-P/M) assessment.
- **2 - 3 :** By June 2025, at least 65% of Hispanic students will meet proficiency on Measurement of Academic Progress in math (MAP-P/M) assessment.
- **4 - 5:** By June 2025, at least 80 % of Hispanic students will exceed the projected RIT score on MAP-M based on their initial achievement level.
 - Students at Achievement Level 1 will grow by 125% or more of the NWEA Fall to Spring Projected Growth
 - Students at Achievement Level 2 will grow by 120% or more of the NWEA Fall to Spring Projected Growth
 - Students at Achievement Level 3 will grow by 115% or more of the NWEA Fall to Spring Projected Growth.
 - Students at Achievement Level 4 will grow by 110% or more of the NWEA Fall to Spring Projected Growth.
- By June 2025, at least 31% of grade 3 - 5 students who receive Special Education services will meet the academic milestone for literacy on MCAP for the spring administration (from 29.1%) (ATSI)

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Culture/Climate SMARTIE Goals

- By June 2025, we will continue to increase the percentage of parent participation by 10% or 18 more parents
- By June 2025, we will increase the percentage of our Hispanic students' beliefs around feeling that their teacher believes in them will increase from 72% to 75%.

Well-Being SMARTIE Goals

- By June 2025, we will decrease the percentage of students habitually truant from 35% to 30%.
