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### Math Focus

Module 4 builds upon Module 2's work with place value within 20, now focusing on the role of place value in the addition and subtraction of numbers to 40. Students study, organize, and manipulate numbers within 40. Students use fingers, linking cubes, dimes, and pennies to represent numbers to 40 in various ways—from all ones to tens and ones. We will use a place value chart to organize units. The topic closes with the identification of 1 more, 1 less, 10 more, and 10 less as students learn to add or subtract like units.

# Reading and Writing Focus

**Knowledge:** Domain 7 concentrates on the history of the earth and geographical features of earth. The read alouds focus on rocks, minerals, fossils, basics of geology and paleontology. Using previous skills, students will create friendly letters throughout the domain. We will also begin Domain 8 focusing on the wonder of the natural world through animals and habitats and their interconnectedness.

**Skills:** As we continue unit 4, there is an emphasis on r-controlled vowels, two-syllable words, and past tense words. Students will continue to read and answer comprehension questions from the decodable and informational text, "*The Green Fern Zoo*". Spelling Tests continue in this unit. Through writing, students will practice descriptive and informational writing while using plausible spelling.

## Science and Social Studies Focus

We will continue with our social studies curriculum, focusing on models and representations of our world. We will primarily focus on on how they give us information to locate and describe places. Additionally, we will also learn more about how people modify, protect, and adapt to their environments in order to meet their needs, connecting to information they will hear in read-alouds during knowledge domain 8.
