# LEARNING FOCUS

<u>Math-</u> We will be completing Module 3 of Eureka Math with topics E, F, G, and H. Students will be identifying and creating a set of more, less and equal amounts, as well as, comparing sets and numerals. We will compare numerals using materials and answering questions such as, "Which set has more cubes?" and "Which set has fewer objects?" We will emphasize using units to show the comparison. They will be using language such as, more/less than.

### **Learning Focus continued**

### Language Arts-

In January we will continue to study Native American cultures and civilizations by reading a variety of texts to compare and contrast three significant tribes in American history. Ask your students about the Lenape, Lakota Sioux, and Wampanoag this month! We will also begin our unit on Kings and Queens at the end of January! We are continuing to make our way through the alphabet, conquering sounds as we become master readers and writers!

**Health-** At the end of January, we learn about safety and injury prevention, including how to get help in an emergency.

Science- Students finish analyzing weather to answer the question, "Does our weather stay the same or change?" They learn how to stay safe in severe weather.
