LEARNING FOCUS

Math- In June, we will be working on module 6 and have another opportunity to explore geometry. We will build and draw two-dimensional flat shapes and three-dimensional solid shapes. We will use ordinal numbers (first, second, third, etc.) to describe the position of a shape. We will also use pattern blocks and two-dimensional shapes to make larger shapes, such as making a square from two triangles.

Reading- After reviewing what we learned in Unit 8 for one day, we will fishing reading in June by using various texts to practice and reinforce what we have learned this year. We will talk about story elements and key details of a story, including characters, setting, beginning, middle, and end. Science- In June, we will use observations to describe patterns of what plants and animals (including humans) need to survive. We hope your students get outside in this nice warm weather and enjoy science outdoors!
