
EV WRAP DESIGN



2024 CONTEST GUIDELINES









ELIGIBILITY AND ARTWORK

Montgomery County Public Schools middle and high school students and all MCPS staff are invited to create hand-drawn or digital artwork that will be displayed on the exterior body of full-sized electric vehicle (EV) cargo vans. Artwork may be hand-drawn or created digitally. It must be the original work of an MCPS staff member or a secondary-level student, and must not contain any copyrighted elements or any personal information that identifies the artist or their school. Entries should be work that the artist has created alone; group projects are not permitted. Physical entries should be no smaller than 8.5" x 11" and must not exceed 18" x 24" in size. Digital files should be no greater than 8,000KB (8MB). Artwork must contain

18" x 24" in size. Digital files should be no greater than 8,000KB (8MB). Artwork must contain the **MCPS** acronym and the slogan **Committed to Sustainability**. It must also promote the use of electric vehicles and/or the use of renewable energy sources.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

All entries must be accompanied by the official contest entry form, which can be found online.

Scan the QR code or visit www.MCPSsustainability.org. Student entry forms must be approved and signed by the student's parent or guardian and the school principal. Staff entries do not require approval.

Three entries per grade level per school will be accepted. Schools are asked to hold preliminary competitions and submit their best three entries to DSC. Entries may be mailed to DSC via Pony or First-Class Mail, or delivered by hand to the address below. Digital artwork should be emailed to **sustainability@mcpsmd.org**. All submissions must be delivered to DSC on/before February 2, 2024. Upon submission, all entries become the property of MCPS. Artwork and artist information may be used by MCPS and/or Montgomery County Government in public awareness campaigns. DSC will not be responsible for lost or damaged artwork.

An MCPS Google login will be required to cast your online vote. Contest winners will be announced in April, 2024.
