

Registration information for new students at Rock View ES!

Do you or someone you know have a child who will turn 5 years old on or before Sept. 1? MCPS has launched an online registration/enrollment process to support families who wish to enroll their child(ren) in MCPS! This process is for registration for next year's kindergarten class, as well as for students who are new to MCPS. Due to continued restrictions, our in-person, traditional kindergarten orientation event will not occur this spring. The digital enrollment process enables families to complete their enrollment electronically, including uploading all the required forms. Here is how you get started to enroll your child!

If you are a current MCPS family:

- With ParentVUE accounts: Register a child for school by clicking on the Online Registration link in the [parent portal](#).
- No ParentVUE: Please contact our school for an activation letter.

If your family is NEW to MCPS:
