Literacy:

Knowledge: In February, we will be working in Knowledge 7: The History of the Earth

Skills: Students will begin working in skills 4. Students are learning to spell and read the following vowel patterns: • /or/ spelled 'or' as in born • /ar/ spelled 'ar' as in bark • /er/ spelled 'er' as in fern. Students will be introduced to 3 new tricky words and two-syllable words in this skills unit. The grammar lessons in this unit focus on past tense verbs ending formed by adding -ed. Math: We began module 4: Place Value, Comparison, Addition and Subtraction to 40. Students will be representing and solving problems using addition and subtraction. We will be extending the counting sequence to 40 (we will eventually count to 120), and understand place value (tens and one). Students will understand that the two digits of a two-digit number represent amounts of tens and ones. We will then compare two two-digit numbers based on meaning of the tens and ones digits, recording the results of comparisons with the symbols $>$, $=$, and $<$. Finally, we will use place value understanding and properties of operations to add and subtract.

Social Studies/Science/Health: In November we will focus on Social Studies instruction, Geography. Students will explore maps, globes, and use geographic tools to identify their place in the world.
