Principal's Message on 08/18

Good Evening Stallions,

Thank you to the families that were able to come to Open House last week! It was great seeing so many of our students and their families.

Tomorrow is the first day of school and we are excited for a new school year!

- Please talk with your child(ren) about how they will go home after school (walk, bus, car rider, or BAR-T).
- Label your child's supplies.
- If your child completed the summer enrichment activities, please have them return the cover sheet to their teacher during the first week of school.
- Please label any donations for the grade level with the teacher's name.

This is a great opportunity for you to walk your child(ren) to their classroom for a quick drop-off! At 9:00 our bell to begin school will ring and we will ask all families to exit the building so we can begin our learning for the day!

Our Daily Schedule

Our day begins with morning announcements and instruction promptly at 9:00 AM, therefore, all students should arrive no later than 8:55 AM, so they have time to unpack and prepare for the day. Keep in mind that supervision of students is not available prior to 8:45 AM. Please monitor the time that walkers leave for school and ensure that car riders remain in your vehicle until an adult is on duty to prevent students from being unsupervised.

New:Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

Based on the needs of our building, safety is our top priority. In order to keep all of our students safe at dismissal, we are trying a new dismissal pattern. We ask for your patience as we navigate this new process.

• Arrival Procedures:

- K students will be dropped off at the door by the ramp on Newcut Road 8:45-8:55. Staff will be there to help escort them to their classrooms.
- K teachers should stand outside their classrooms in the hallways to greet students as they arrive.
- 1st 5th walkers will enter through the main entrance and go directly to classrooms where teachers will greet them at the door.

• Car riders will be dropped off at the main entrance as they arrive and greeted/helped by a staff member/patrol.

• Dismissal Procedures:

- Dismissal will begin at 3:25 pm, but patrols will be dismissed at 3:20 pm.
- Kindergarten walkers will be dismissed first to the blacktop in the back of the school by the playground.
 - This is where parents and older siblings will pick the students up.
 - The gate will be open to allow for parents to walk to the blacktop from the ramp on Newcut Road.
 - All other grades will be dismissed out the door by the gym that goes to the ramp on Newcut Road.
 - Third, fourth and fifth graders will be dismissed and can leave when they exit the building.
 - 1st and 2nd grade will bring their kids out and line them up inside the fence to help with dismissing students to the correct adult/sibling.
