Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a graduating high school senior
- Must have a grade point average or a weighted grade point average of 3.0 or above
- Must participate in extracurricular activities
- Must participate in faith-based, religious-based, or volunteer activities. If this is not possible because of paid employment, please explain
- Completed scholarship application due by Friday, March 21, 2025

How to Apply:

- Complete the official application form. The application form may be reproduced but may not be altered and must be filled out completely.
- Submit an unofficial copy of school transcripts and two school references (original copies on school stationary), including one from a guidance counselor or an administrator.

- Submit a 300-word, double-spaced, typed essay, which addresses the theme, "The Fight for Justice Continues!" Students are encouraged to provide their own personal interpretation of the theme. The essay must accompany the application. In addition, a three to four paragraph typed narrative essay about the applicant must be included.
