





Student-Athletes MUST have a CURRENT physical to try-out.





## **New Policies**



#### Personal Mobile device (PMD) Policy

- Students may use their PMDs before school, between classes, and at lunch

- There is an Intervention process

- Superintendent Taylor has stated that one of his top priorities is safety
- MCPS is piloting program where all HS students & staff are required to wear IDs
- Northwest HS is providing lanyards for students and staff





## Grading and Reporting

#### **Grading and Reporting**

- MCPS has updated the Grading and Reporting policy
- Northwest Grading and Reporting policy is in alignment with MCPS policy
- The All Tasks and Assignments category must have between 9-18 per MP
- Interventions must be granted before a grade of zero may be given
- Interventions must be documented in Synergy
- RTs drafted a policy that is customized for Northwest
- Flowchart established
