WATKINS MILL CLUSTER SERVICES

SOCIAL SERVICES CARE COORDINATION

- Coordinate financial Security Resources (Food/SNAP) Temporary Cash Assistance (TCA)
- Housing stabilization support (eviction, rental assistance, utilities)
- Obtain Health Services (access to medical care, vision, hearing,
- dental) Employment and Legal support
- Access summer and recreational programs

EARLY CHILHOOD CASE MANAGEMENT

- Coordinate Early childhood services
- Assist pregnant teens and young parents of infant and preschool age children to connect them to community resources
- Train parents to promote healthy parent-child development and relationships.





BEHAVIORAL/ MENTAL HEALTH ACCESS AND SUPPORT

- Support families in gaining access to mental and behavioral health support
- Provide Assessments and referrals to services (individual/ family therapy, support groups)
- Follow-up to ensure service connection and progress
