This letter is to inform you of the upcoming dates for state testing at Parkland. All students in grades 6-8 will take the Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP) for English/Language Arts and Math. Eighth grade students will also take the Science MCAP and the Social MCAP. Classroom instruction will continue when students do not have exams. The bell and classroom schedule will be modified throughout testing, however, school is still from 8:15-3pm. All students will also take the MSDE Student Survey (please see the second page for more information on the survey) as well.

## Dear parent/guardian:

State law requires that all public schools in Maryland survey students about school climate. The purpose of the MSDE survey is to gain valuable information about the quality and character of each school's learning environment so that schools can promote a climate that supports student learning.

Students will take the Maryland School Survey during regular school hours between 8:15am-3:00pm. The survey will ask students about topics such as student engagement, interactions with adults and with other students in the school, the school environment, bullying, and safety. The survey will not ask about a student's personal experiences, and students will not be asked to provide any information that might violate their privacy.

The survey is confidential and school personnel will not have access to the responses of specific students. The responses your child provides will be combined with the responses from other students in the school, and results will be reported for each school and district.

We are eager to receive this very important information about your student's school and about schools across the state.
