Intramural Sports: Frequently Asked Questions

What are intramural sports?

Intramural programs provide students with a variety of interesting, diverse, and challenging activities to accommodate differing levels of need, skill, readiness, and interests. Each school's program is individualized to reflect the needs and interests of all its students. The primary reason for participation is enjoyment of the activity rather than pressure to compete and win. Such an environment will enable students to grow, develop positive attitudes, increase self-esteem, enjoy positive social interactions, and broaden their leisure horizons.

Are there tryouts?

There will never be tryouts for intramural sports. All boys and girls in grades 6, 7, and 8 are invited to participate with parent permission.

When do the intramural sports take place?

Intramural sports will run on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Each sport will meet once per week. Check the schedule for more details.

Can students participate in more than one intramural sport?

Yes, as long as they meet on different days

<u>Is there transportation provided?</u>
