Restaurant Management/Culinary Arts

The program includes food preparation in a commercial kitchen, a student-run restaurant, snack bar, catering-event experience, and a production bake sale. Students learn food safety principles, professional food-handling techniques, and quantity preparation through the use of commercial equipment and standardized recipes. Sanitation, safety, personal hygiene, and workplace skills are emphasized daily. All students have the opportunity to earn the ServSafe Food Protection Managers License (formerly known as a Food Handlers License). This program offers students the ability to complete the course as a program completer, for Maryland high school graduation requirement, or as an elective credit.



Each year, Thomas Edison High School of Technology proudly opens its student-operated **Café Edison**. Guests enjoy the delectable cuisine planned and prepared by the Restaurant Management student chefs. Additionally, table service is provided by the student servers from the **National Academy of Hospitality and Tourism**.
