

Immunization Requirements for the 2019–2020 School Year

All incoming Grade 7 students, regardless of the date of entry into the school system, must receive vaccination against Tetanus-diphtheria-acellular pertussis (Tdap) and Meningococcal meningitis (MCV4) prior to the start of the 2019–2020 school year. In addition, all students newly enrolled in Grades 8 through 12 are required to have one Tdap and MCV4 vaccination. Students will be required to provide documentation of the required Tdap and MCV4 immunizations.

Parents/guardians should contact their doctor to make sure their child is properly immunized and submit a copy of the documentation to the child's school health nurse as soon as possible, but no later than the first day of the 2019–2020 school year on Tuesday, September 3. To ensure all students have a chance to receive the necessary immunizations, the Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services will hold free clinics for students in September.
